Municipal elections on 22 May 2011

EU citizens may vote in the municipal elections if they express their wish to exercise that right in Spain

The Electoral Census Office has sent a communication to 757,495 EU citizens to enable the paperwork

Citizens who are nationals of other countries of the European Union (EU) and are aged 18 years old or more on that day may vote in the municipal elections of 22 May 2011.

In order to vote it is a requirement to have expressed one's wish to exercise that right beforehand, paperwork which it has been possible to carry out in municipal councils on an ongoing basis since 2006.

Those who have expressed this wish and continue to be resident in Spain remain voters, without the need to complete a fresh statement. There is currently a total of 363,881 voters who are nationals of other countries of the European Union for the municipal elections.

Paperwork for expressing one's wish to vote

EU citizens, who are on the municipal register and wish to vote but have not yet expressed their wish to exercise their right to vote, must do so. In order to enable this paperwork, the Electoral Census Office has posted a communication to 757,495 registered persons who were not written to on previous occasions and have not expressed that wish since the 2007 municipal elections.

These citizens need only complete and sign the formal statement contained in the communication and send it to the corresponding Provincial Delegation of the Electoral Census Office. Moreover, those with a Registration number in the Register of Foreign Nationals may express their wish online, by going to the Electronic Headquarters on the website of the National Statistics Institute: <u>https://sede.ine.gob.es/en</u>

In turn, those resident in Spain and **are not on the Municipal Register should go to their Municipal Council** to be included on the municipal register and then, if they wish to do, complete the statement for voting in Spain.

Voters by province

The largest presence of voters who are nationals of other countries of the EU is in the provinces of Alicante/Alacant (with 67,139), Madrid (44,725) and Málaga (35,740).

In turn, the greatest potential growth in voters, corresponding to the sending of communications, was recorded in Madrid (119,947), Barcelona (66,884) and Alicante/Alacant (64,952).

Voters by country

By country, the greatest presence of voters from the European Union corresponds to nationals of the a United Kingdom (91,948), Rumania (81,496), Germany (43,780), Italy (34,488) and France (29,498).

In turn, the greatest potential growth, corresponding to the sending of communications, is expected for nationals of Rumania (312,941), the United Kingdom (90,850), Italy (62,382), Bulgaria (57,882) and Portugal (56,749).
