Industrial Companies Survey 2009

Industrial turnover decreases 21.1% in 2009, standing at 496,296 million euros

The number of employed persons decreases 12.5%

The net amount of turnover of industrial companies reached 496,296 million euros in 2009, indicating an increase of 21.1% as compared with the previous year. In turn, the number of persons employed in industrial companies stood at 2,199,532, that is, 12.5% less than in 2008.

Structure of operating income

Sales of products accounted for the majority of operating income in 2009, to be specific, 77.7%. In turn, sales of merchandise amounted to 13.2% and services rendered, 6.0%. Other operating income overall reached 3.0% of the total.

Structure of operating costs

The main components in the structure of operating costs in 2009 were purchases of raw materials (representing 41.3% of the total), personnel costs (15.9%), external services (14.7%) and purchases of goods (10.3%).


Geographical markets

Regarding the destination of sales in the year 2009, 77% thereof corresponded to sales within Spain, while those aimed at other European Union countries represented 17%, and those to the rest of the world, 6%.

Regarding purchases of raw material, merchandise, etc. 68% were from within Spain, whereas 18% came from European Union countries, and 14% from countries from the rest of the world.

Investment

The total industrial investment of companies reached 32,733 million euros in 2009. It is worth noting that 40.1% of this figure corresponded to "*Technical installations*" and 17.1% to "*Machinery*".



Results by group of activity

The groups of activity with greatest contribution to total turnover of the industrial sector in 2009 were "Mining and quarrying industries, energy, water and waste" (with 21.7% of the total), "Food, beverages and tobacco" (18.6%) and "Transport material" (11.9%).


Regarding the groups that employed the greatest number of people, of note were "Food, beverages and tobacco" (with 16.7% of the total) and "Metallurgy and manufacture of metallic products" (16.0%).


By evolution of turnover, the group that experienced the greatest interannual decrease was "Metallurgy and manufacture of metal products, except machinery and equipment" (with a 34.3% decrease).

In turn, the greatest interannual decrease in the number of persons employed (20.4%) corresponded to "Textile, clothing, leather and footwear industries".

Results by activity sector

The sectors with greatest contribution to total turnover in 2009 were "Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy" (10.5% of the total), "Manufacture of motor vehicles" (6.13%) and "Petroleum and natural gas industry" (5.6%).

Results by company size interval

The total number of companies with 1,000 or more employed persons generated 28.6% of the total industrial turnover in 2009. If we consider the total number of companies with more than 100 employees, the aforementioned percentage rose to 65.3%.

Results by Autonomous Community

Cataluña (23.5% of the total), (10.9%), Comunidad de Madrid (10.6%) and Andalucía (10.6%) were the Autonomous Communities which contributed the most to industrial sector turnover in 2009.
