Elections to the Parliament of Andalucía and the General Council of Principado de Asturias, of 25 March 2012

Those voters resident abroad who wish to vote must apply to vote by 25 February

The electoral census will be available for query from 6 to 13 February

This coming 25 March 2012, a total of 6,404,623 voters will be able to vote in the elections to the Parliament of Andalucía, and 989,732 in the elections to the General Council of Principado de Asturias.

368,103 of the voters resident **in Andalucía will be able to participate for the first time** in these elections, having turned 18 years of age since the previous election to the Parliament of Andalucía, held on 9 March 2008.

In turn, **5,862 voters resident in Principado de Asturias will be able to participate for the first time** in these elections, having turned 18 years of age since the previous election to the General Council of Principado de Asturias, held on 22 May 2011.

Those voters resident abroad and who wish to vote must apply to vote at the Provincial Delegation of the Electoral Census Office corresponding to their registration, no later than 25 February, using the official form sent by that Office to their postal addresses of residence abroad.

Voter claims

The electoral census will be available for query from 6 to 13 February in the municipal councils and in the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office. Voters resident abroad may check their registration data during this same period in the different consulates.

Voters may submit claims regarding their registration data in the municipal councils or consulates, or in the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office, during the same period, from 6 to 13 February.

Census cards

The Electoral Census Office will issue, to each voter resident in Andalucía or Principado de Asturias, a census card with the information on the polling station and electoral premises where he or she is registered to vote, beginning on 27 February.

Voter query processing

The website of the National Statistics Institute (<http://www.ine.es>) provides information of interest regarding the actions of the Electoral Census Office in these elections, voter counts, claims, polling stations and electoral premises, postal votes, deadlines and legal regulations.

Also online, the Electronic Headquarters of the INE <https://sede.ine.gob.es> provides a **service for queries on the registration data** in the electoral census and on the **polling station and electoral premises**, once the identity of the voter has been accredited using a recognised electronic certificate (electronic ID card, for example)

Likewise, there is a general query service, not requiring accreditation, for the polling stations and electoral premises of any district, through the Headquarters itself.

Lastly, the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office shall answer those queries activities of their jurisdiction (registration in the census, polling stations and electoral premises, census cards, postal vote, etc.) at their offices and the following telephone number: **901101900**.
