The National Statistics Institute receives an "Honourable Mention" at the European Parliament headquarters

The INE receives an award at the *Five Star Awards* organised by PSI Alliance

The National Statistics Institute (INE) has been awarded an "Honourable Mention" at the *Five Star Awards* organised by PSI Alliance. This European group is comprised of private companies (including Google, Tom Tom, Infotrader, Teleatlas, etc.) that use information from the public sector as a fundamental part of their business models.

This award is granted to those public institutions that provide the best conditions for the access and re-use of the information that they provide. On granting it, the jury has highlighted "the excellent work carried out by the INE", both in the availability of non-aggregated information in files for public use, and in the conditions established for re-use and the price policy used.

The candidature of the INE for these awards was proposed by the Spanish Multi-sector Information Association (ASEDIE), which is a member of PSI Alliance.

The Assistant Director-General for Statistical Dissemination, Adolfo Gálvez, has attended this event in representation of the INE, to receive the "Honourable Mention" at the headquarters of the European Parliament in Brussels.
