The Professional Life of People with Disabilities (PLPD)¹ Year 2018

This operation, which integrates statistical data provided by the Social Security Ongoing Sample of Professional Life with administrative data registered in the IMSERSO State Database of Persons with Disabilities, is being published for the first time by INE. More information on its preparation can be found in the methodological note at the end of this press release, as well as on the INE website.

Main results

- In 2018, 10% of persons who were in some way associated with Social Security had an officially recognized disability. That was a total of 3,105,500 persons.
- For 20.0% of them (621,200), this association consisted of being registered for work at some point during the year. This percentage was 55.7 points lower than that recorded for the non-disabled population. Among persons with disabilities who were registered, there was a higher percentage of men and those over 45 years of age than for persons without disabilities, as well as a predominance of persons with a lower degree of disability.
- Persons with disabilities who were registered for employment registered an average of 1.75 times in 2018, compared to 2.12 in the case of those who did not have a disability.
- In 2018, 31.6% of employment affiliations for persons with disabilities were permanent contracts, compared to 27.7% for persons without disabilities.
- For 85.8% persons with disabilities who had a relationship with Social Security in 2018, the relationship consisted of being a pensioner at some point in the year. This percentage falls to 23.0% in the case of the population without disabilities.

Characteristics of persons affiliated with Social Security

¹ These are persons with a degree of disability greater than or equal to 33% and who have been assimilated (according to Royal Legislative Decree 1/2013).

Of the total number of persons aged 16 or over (31,135,600) who had some type of relationship with Social Security in 2018, 3,105,500 (10% of the total) had a disability.

For 77.5%, this relationship consisted solely of receiving a pension, compared to 20.8% of persons without disabilities. On the other hand, 316,800 people with disabilities (10.2%) were affiliated with Social Security exclusively because they were registered for work at least one day during the year, compared to 61.2% in the case of persons without disabilities.

For the remaining 12.3% of persons with disabilities who had some type of relationship with Social Security in 2018, this involvement took various forms: receipt of unemployment, pensioner and work registration benefits, unemployment and release, etc.



Units: percentage




Characteristics of persons registered with Social Security

The most notable aspect of the group of persons with disabilities is their low participation in the labour market. This makes them less likely to have registered to work. A total of 621,200 people with disabilities were registered at some point during the year, either exclusively or in rotation with another type of situation. This represented 20.0 of the total number of people with disabilities who had some kind of relationship with Social Security . This percentage was more than 55 points lower than for the population without disabilities (75.7%).

Among persons with disabilities, the distribution by sex showed a higher percentage of men. In terms of age groups, the population with disabilities that registered for work at some point in 2018 was concentrated in the highest brackets: more than 60% were between 45 and 64 years old. The greatest difference is found in the 55-64 age bracket - with 28.9% of people with disabilities - compared to 15.4% among the population without disabilities. By nationality, a lower proportion of the foreign population is found among persons with disabilities (2.8% compared to 12.1%).

Demographic characteristics of the population registered for employment with Social Security. Year 2018



Participation in the labour market is heavily determined by the type and intensity of the disability. Among persons registered with Social Security at some point in 2018, the weight of those with a lower degree of disability was 55.7%. This progressively decreased to 2.7% with higher degrees of disability.



Those who had deficiencies in the *osteoarticular system* represented 23.9% of the persons with disabilities who were registered for employment. The lowest representation corresponded to those who had a type of disability associated with the *digestive, metabolic and endocrine systems*, with 3.8%.

Affiliations in employment registration with Social Security


Each person affiliated with Social Security could have one or more registrations in 2018. Persons with disabilities had a total of 1,088,800 Social Security employment registrations, or 1.75 affiliations per member. In the case of persons without disabilities, each affiliate had an average of 2.12 registrations during the year.

This difference was also corroborated by the fact that 47.7% of the registrations for persons with disabilities remained active throughout the year, compared to 40.0% for people without disabilities. Furthermore, 73.1% of affiliates with disabilities had only one registration during the year, compared with 66.3% for those without a disability.

In 2018, 31.6% of employment affiliations for persons with disabilities were permanent contracts, compared to 27.7% in the case of persons without disabilities.

Characteristics of persons who receive a contributory Social Security pension


Since having a permanent disability pension means that someone is considered disabled, we find a greater number of persons with disabilities among pensioners. Of the total number of persons with disabilities who had some relationship with Social Security in 2018, 2,663,100 received a contributory pension (85.8% of the total). The percentage was 23.0% for those without disabilities.

Men had a greater weight among pensioners with disabilities than among those without (57.2% compared to 49.3%).

Only in the group of people over 65 years of age did persons with disabilities have a significantly lower representation among pensioners (58.2% versus 87.0% among people without disabilities).

Demographic characteristics of the population with a contributory Social Security pension. Year 2018



Regarding pensioner type and degree of disability, we see a distribution very similar to that of affiliation, with a predominance of deficiencies of the *Osteoarticular system* and an increase in the percentage of pensioners with the maximum degree of disability (9.7% compared to 2.7% of registered affiliates). In 2018, 40.6% of disabled pensioners who have a recognized permanent disability and are not registered in the State Database of persons with disabilities (SDPD). These people do not have a recognized type and degree of disability.

Distribution of the disabled population with a contributory Social Security pension, according to type of disability. Year 2018



Methodological note

The aim of the PLPD is to obtain information about the professional life of people with disabilities, in comparative terms with people without disabilities. It is based on data from administrative records.

For the purposes of this statistic, persons with disabilities are considered to be those with a degree of disability equal to or greater than 33% and similar, according to Legislative Royal Decree 1/2013. By virtue of Royal Legislative Decree 1/2013, which approved the Consolidated Text of the “General Law on rights for persons with disabilities and their social inclusion”, social security pensioners who also have a recognized disability pension to the degree of total, long-term or severe disability will be considered as having a degree of disability greater than or equal to 33%, and state pensioners who have a retirement pension or retirement due to permanent incapacity or unfitness for work.

The PLPD is contemplated in the National Statistical Plan and in the Annual Programs. It uses information provided by the IMSERSO and Social Security, who have signed a collaboration agreement with the INE to elaborate these statistics. It has also benefited from collaboration with the Spanish Committee of Representatives of People with Disabilities (CERMI) and the ONCE Foundation.

Type of operation: Continuous annual survey.

Population scope: Persons aged 16 and over with an officially recognized degree of disability greater than or equal to 33% and similar, who have had some relationship with Social Security, either as a member or as a pensioner, for at least one day in the reference year.

Geographical scope: The entire national territory.

Reference period of the results and information: Annual.

Source data: integration of statistical data provided by the Social Security Ongoing Sample of Professional Life with administrative data registered in the IMSERSO State Database of Persons with Disabilities².
